WHAT IS LGBTQ+?

When RVT Future use the term *LGBTQ+ Community* in the context of those who already use the Tavern, and also those we'd like to see use and help shape a Community-minded Royal Vauxhall Tavern, broadly speaking we're referring to any group of people that would like to use the RVT for socialising, culture and performance in a spirit of inclusivity for the benefit of everyone.

That includes (but is not limited to) all people who identify as LGBTQI+ regardless of ability, race, gender, religion, political affiliation, class, background or sexual orientation.

It also includes local community groups and artists/performers from further afield who might not identify as LGBTQI+ but respect the venue's long-standing ethos.

LGBTQI+ stands for "Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans*, Queer, Questioning, Intersex and others (which embraces any and all sexualities including heterosexuality)", though we often used the shortened term *LGBTQ+* or *LGBTQ*.

Inclusivity and acceptance of *everybody* as equal is the key.
